


nterior designer Tara Fingold has a knack for combining formal flair with casual comfort. She put her talents to work on a Toronto house with "no charm but lots of potential," which she and her husband, Michael, bought eight years ago. By eliminating some walls and adopting a mostly open-concept floor plan, they blurred the boundaries between the kitchen, eating and living areas. The result? A family-friendly home that's perfect for the couple and their two young children, not to mention a stream of guests. Find out how Tara did it.


BREAKFAST ROOM Choose versatile pieces for an openconcept space. For this casual eating area, Tara upholstered the chairs in a faux leather that's the same colour as the dining room chairs, so they can be moved during parties. The wicker chest and outdoor chandelier maintain the relaxed feel.

f 1 White kitchen cabinetry with Shaker-style doors can easily be dressed up with hardware and colourful accessories.
